He is an accomplished conservation photographer, with a background in wildlife and conservation biology. Roy was awarded this year's Gerald Durrell award for Endangered Species in this year's BBC Wildlife Photographer of the Year. His images have been featured in National Geographic, Smithsonian, Audubon, Wildlife Conservation, Discover magazines and other notable publications.

This 165-acre park was named after Richard Shollenberger, a Park Department chief. It has become increasingly popular since its opening in 1995. Several hundred people visit it daily: walking the family dog, jogging, or just enjoying nature; especially the many species of birds that can be seen here. The park features a two-mile circular trail and a one-mile trail through Alman Marsh to the Petaluma Marina.
